

AYSO Section 10 Area S - Under 16/19 Program 2009

Player's Fair Play Pledge

As a prospective Player in the AYSO Section 10 Area S U16/19 program, I hereby acknowledge and voluntarily agree to the following:

1. I understand that fighting may result in my permanent removal from the program. Any actions which are violent towards another person are considered fighting and may result in removal from the program. This includes but is not limited to kicking, head-butting, punching, slapping, spitting and violent pushing.
2. I understand that pets of any type are prohibited from AYSO fields.
3. I understand that the use of tobacco products, whether smoked or chewed, is prohibited from AYSO fields and the vicinity.
4. I understand that alcohol or any other controlled substance is prohibited at, or in the vicinity of, the soccer fields, and that playing under the influence of alcohol or any other substance (controlled or otherwise) is prohibited. If I am in violation of either of these, I understand that it will result in my removal from the program.
5. I understand that the abuse of game officials, coaches, players and/or spectators will not be tolerated and will result in suspension. The term "abuse" includes, but is not limited to, foul language, offensive gestures, spitting, sexist or racial remarks or any remark or gesture intended to provoke another person. Persistent abuse will result in further suspensions and may eventually result in removal from the program.
6. I understand that bringing anything to an AYSO function or field which poses a threat to me or to others shall be cause for my immediate removal from the program. Prohibited items include, but are not limited to, firearms, weapons, explosives, or other dangerous substances which could be dangerous to participants or spectators.
7. I understand that it is my responsibility to conform to the age limitations for my division and that, as a condition of continuing participation in play, I may be requested to provide proof of my date of birth. Such proof may be my certified certificate of birth, my valid passport, my valid driver's license, my valid Student I.D. card or a similar proof acceptable to the Area 10S Director.
8. I understand that this is a recreational program and I agree that I shall behave in a manner consistent with such. I agree:
 - a. To recognize any injury and bring injuries to the attention of a match official in a courteous and timely manner.
 - b. To refrain from overly aggressive play that could result in serious injury.
 - c. To refrain from questioning the competence, impartiality and/or authority of **any** official.
 - d. To act in a manner consistent with maintaining the safety and enjoyment of all players and participants.

The Dispute Resolution Board will review all "Red Cards", "Yellow Cards" and other reported incidents. The Dispute Resolution Board will consist of the Area Director, the Area Referee Administrator, the Area Coach Administrator and a member at large. Input will be received from all affected parties including the Regional Commissioner(s) from the region(s) affected. The Dispute Resolution Board will notify the Regional Commissioner(s) of the final decision(s) made. Each Regional Commissioner will be required to notify the player and/or other party regarding the nature and duration of any suspensions received and whether or not the player will be suspended for the remainder of the season. Decisions of the Dispute Resolution Board are final.

This form must be signed by the Player (and a Parent or Legal Guardian of a minor Player as indicated above) in order for the Player to participate in this U16/19 program.
